It's not too late to join us for our FOCUS Weekend Away at Coolum Beach! We still have plenty of space for big and small groups. Registrations close tomorrow - Monday 11 May.

Going away can be a little daunting, but you can expect:

- **Bible Talks:** Stephen McAlpine is joining us for two sessions (Saturday morning) and will be preaching as we gather for a Service on Sunday. We're going to be looking at how we are gathered together as God's people.
- **St Bart's Kids Program:** During the Saturday morning sessions, there will be a concurrent kids program for children Year 6 and below (including a creche).
- **Small Groups:** You'll get to meet a small group of adults, to unpack the teaching and pray together. Youth will get to connect with each other in their own small groups.
- **Connect with others:** Across meals together, bonfire, wine & cheese Friday & Saturday night, relaxed evenings, and optional activities - there is plenty of unstructured & relaxed time to meet others, have longer conversations than on a Sunday.
- **Beach:** We can see the ocean from where the talks are held, and the beach is just across the road. There is plenty of time to explore it early mornings and in the afternoon.
- **Delicious food:** all meals (except Friday dinner) are provided by Luther Heights. They are well equipped to handle any dietary requirement.
- **Accommodation flexibility:** there are a range of room sizes, for what might suit you best.
