I'm so thankful for the generous ways that people serve in the life of our church! In 1 Peter 4, we are reminded of the extraordinary news that every believer has been given gifts in God's grace to be stewarded for his glory.

Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen. — 1 Peter 4:10-11

In fact, there are at least five reasons why we serve:

1. Serving is an act of worship (*Romans 12:1*)
2. Serving enables us to take our part in the building up of the Church (*Ephesians 4:11-13*)
3. Serving is a way to steward God-given gifts (*1 Peter 4:10*)
4. Serving is in imitation of Christ (*Mark 10:45*)
5. Serving is a way to love Christ's body (*Galatians 5:13*)
