## NEWS HIGHLIGHT

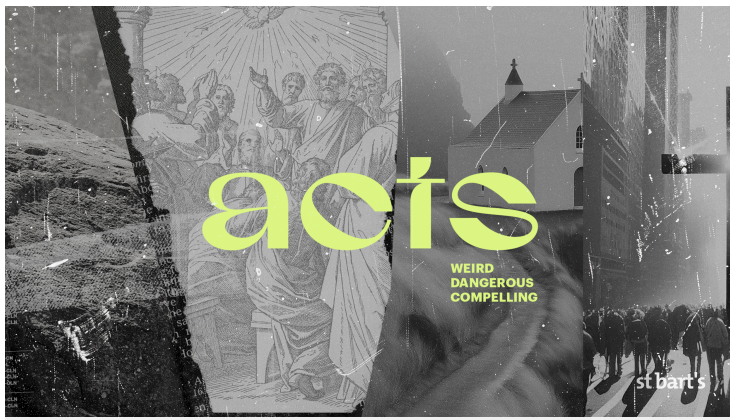
I'm so thankful to God for the diverse ways in which many people serve to help make our services as accessible to as many people as possible. This includes: livestreaming, the provision of buses, the buggy in the carpark, a warm welcome, pram and wheelie-walker parking, translation points for the sermon, assistance during the Lord's Supper, screens at the back of the auditorium and in the parent's room. St Bart's Kids also accommodates additional needs for our children. *Please let one of the welcome team know if any of these would be of help to you.*

Improving our accessibility is also one of our five mission goals for VISION 2025. *I'm delighted to share two new ways we're improving accessibility in our Sunday services.*

**#1 Live Translation into Multiple Languages:** We now offer live translation of our 9:30AM service into Korean, Simplified Chinese, Tamil, and Japanese. We're still working to make this seamless, but if you would like to start trialling live translation, all that you need is a smart phone or tablet. When you visit our dedicated link, you will see a text transcription live on your screen in the language of your choosing. You can also try the live audio translation, too (but you'll need headphones!). If there's another language that would be helpful, please let us know. **#2 Auracast:** Whilst we have a hearing aid loop, we are in the early stages of trialling a new technology that offers many advantages. *If you would like to know more, or help trial, please speak to one of the team.*
