Tickets are \$30 each, register online or place your name on the clipboard. If the cost is a barrier, please let me know. stbarts.com.au/events

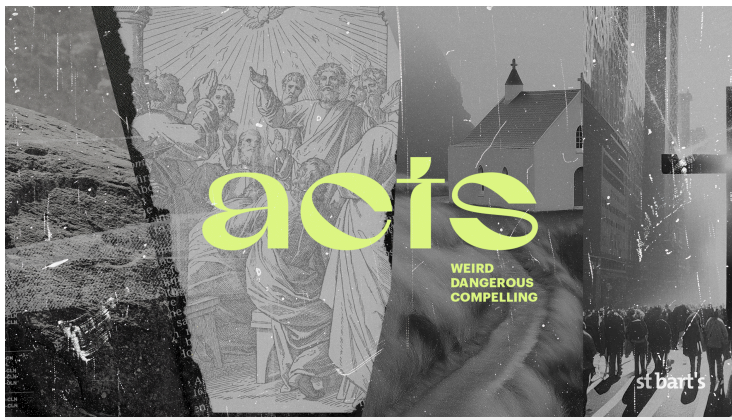
Men's Prayer Chats, join on WhatsApp.
