

NEWS HIGHLIGHT

We have the great privilege of supporting a number of mission partners every year (with financial gifts, prayer, and practical means wherever possible). The financial support that we provide is a key part of our budget, supported by the regular giving. I'm thankful for the work of our Mission Partnerships Committee and the way in which we have been able to establish and nurture long-term relationships with many of our mission partners. In 2026, these partnerships reflect a mix of local, national, and international concerns.

- **CMS (with link missionary, 'M'):** Whilst M's work in the Middle East comes to an end, we will be continuing our partnership with CMS. We should have news soon regarding a new link person. We're so thankful for the time that we've been able to spend with M this week and give praise to God for how he has been so faithfully at work through her.
- **SU:** We support three chaplaincies at Gabbinbar State School, Middle Ridge State Primary School, and Centenary Heights State High School.
- **Anglican Overseas Aid:** AOA work of restoration and renewal, particularly focuses on places experiencing poverty and marginalisation.
- **Bush Church Aid:** We partner with the Langmead family at Lightning Ridge. *There is also another youth mission trip planned this year.*
- **Bishop Daniel:** Daniel supports ethnic congregations in the Anglican Church Southern QLD. We also give to orphanage projects in Uganda supported by Daniel.
