

Next Saturday is a wonderful opportunity to explore and be equipped for serving the body of Christ. It's a delight we are welcoming two guest speakers to the *Equipping the Saints Ministry Conference*:

- **Tim Johnson** is presenting the opening sermon on "Gospel Ministry" & an elective on "Exploring Vocational Ministry". Tim is the Dean of the Anglican Institute at Ridley College, and a lecturer in Preaching and Pastoral Theology.

This one-day includes a selection of three electives (from a choice of 12). These cover a range of areas from:


- Reaching People (from Gen Z to people in Aged Care)
