Paul's letter to the Romans is one of the most important pieces of written correspondence in all of human history. This Sunday, we'll be launching a new two-term series to help us plumb the depths of this remarkable letter and be strengthened by the Good News. Here are 5 ways to help get ready and make the most of the series.

- 1 Listen to the 'Romans in One Hour' Talk by Brian Rosner.** On Saturday (in Toowoomba), Brian Rosner presented a one-hour talk to help us get oriented to Romans. The talk is available on our website, along with some really helpful notes.
