Winter Warmers Series

Jesus' life was profoundly shaped by regular habits and practices that shaped his spiritual and missional life. He regularly retreated in *prayer*, seemed to always be sharing *meals* with others, and *rested* as was his custom. These habits were not without their controversy as he prayed with unrivalled authority, feasted whilst others fasted, shared table-fellowship with all the wrong people, and brought wholeness and healing on the Sabbath. Yet, these practices not only instruct us (as we seek to order in our lives in light of our Saviour) *but also point to the way that our future is fulfilled in Christ.*

Over three weeks we'll explore key habits and practices of Jesus that are on repeat throughout the Gospel of Luke. Each week focuses on one instance of that habit alongside its ultimate expression as fulfilled in Christ.
