In the life of St Bart's, there are many ways to be involved in prayer. This term, I'd encourage you to try one:

- Join us for the upcoming *Prayer Night* (Wed Aug 12, 5:30pm for dinner, 6:30-7:30pm for prayer). This is a night for the whole family. If you're uncomfortable praying with others or don't know where to begin, there are lots of practical prompts in the hour of prayer that you won't be left wondering what to do.
- Pick up a *Prayer Guide*. We'll have a new guide for Term 3 available at the Prayer Night and afterwards. You can use it each day to prompt one or a few points to pray for - not just for our church, but it also includes points for our city, the church, and the world.
- Take the NEWS sheet home and use the points on the back throughout the week to prompt your prayer.
- Join a prayer group or prayer chat. We currently have groups of people meeting regularly to pray for the Children & Families, the Church Plant, and for our Church, along with men prayer chats. You can find out more at stbarts.com.au/prayer
