# **GATHER**

We're committed to gathering together on Sundays to: orientate our hearts to God, confess our sin, rejoice in God's forgiveness, declare God's Good News, feast on God's Word, share in the Lord's Supper, and take our part in the building up of Christ's Church.

We're so thankful for the privilege to gather as one body in Christ yet diverse in generations, ethnicity, and backgrounds. We count it as joy to welcome new people.

On Sundays we gather in-person (7.30am 9.30am 6pm) and online (visit stbarts.online.church — 7.30am and 9.30am). At 9.30am there is a children's program and youth discussion. Sermon points are provided in English, Korean, Dinka, and simplified Chinese.

There are also a number of 'micro sites' (i.e., multiple households who gather together within and beyond Toowoomba and the region).

In 2024, we're continuing to plan and pray towards planting in Brisbane, and extending our digital reach.

#### **TEACHING SERIES IN 2024**

At St Bart's, we hunger to grow in God's life-giving Word. The focus in our teaching series is also reflected in our Small Groups, St Bart's Kids on Sundays, and CHARGE Discussion.

#### TERM 1

Our Mission: A three-part miniseries exploring our mission.

Responding to Jesus (Matthew): Over eleven weeks, we'll consider the varied ways that people responded to the life-changing invitation of Jesus and how that shapes our response.

#### TERM 2

Genesis Part II (Abraham): An eightpart series delving into the story of Abraham and God's unwavering faithfulness to—and through—him.

Winter Warmers: The fruit of the Spirit

and the character of Jesus (3 weeks).

#### TERM 3

Who Am I? Over nine weeks we'll consider how the Gospel brings light and life to every aspect of our identity.

Gospel-Shaped Church (1 Timothy): A seven-part series exploring how the Gospel shapes the focus, function, and fabric of Christian community.

#### TERM 4

Perplexing Passages: A talking donkey, mysterious Nephilim, and the resurrection of the dead! Wrestling with the truth of God's Word and the limits of our knowing (over 3 weeks).

Songs of Advent: Four weeks delighting in the songs of God's grace which announce the arrival of God's King.

#### **CHARGE YOUTH FRIDAYS**

CHARGE Youth meets on Friday nights from 6.30-9.00pm for grades 7-12. Each week brings something different as we explore faith amongst a welcoming community. We begin the night with some chill time and games, before youth in grades 7-9 and 10-12 split up for age-specific activities, teaching, and small group time. The night finishes with all ages joining again for supper. We also have a wide array of fun social nights each term.

During our 9.30am Sunday service, youth in grades 7-12 meet together in age-specific small groups after the sermon to explore weekly questions whilst enjoying snacks. # CENTRE FOR Work+Faith

The Centre for Work + Faith seeks to equip workers to explore how following Jesus transforms why we work, how we work, and how God uses our frontlines for his glory.

Work is where the majority of us spend more of our time. So what does it look like to be a disciple of Jesus in the workplace? The two key ways we seek to equip and encourage workers are through the *Transforming Work* and *RePurpose courses*.

#### TRANSFORMING WORK COURSE

This eight-week course is an opportunity to gather with other workers, explore what following Jesus looks like in the workplace, and pray for one another about the specific challenges and opportunities we have at work. Starting Wednesday 1 May and Wednesday 10 July.


#### **RePURPOSE COURSE**

# **LEADERSHIP** .local

leadership.local is our approach to developing and equipping St Bart's leaders—for all of their frontlines, including the local church.

Leaders at St Bart's (i.e., those responsible for leading teams, ministry areas, or departments) participate in five workshops annually, each focusing on a different aspect essential to leadership. Our hope is that leadership.local equips people to lead not only at St Bart's, but on all of their frontlines in which they serve.

Each module is part of our leadership framework. This framework consists of 20 modules and designed around a carousel (i.e., people can enter at any point on a three-year cycle). New leaders are onboarded using two core modules: (a) Growing as a Disciple; and (b) Understanding Your Strengths.



Leadership.Local Modules: modules are available online for anyone who would like to make use of the materials. There is also a leadership podcast connected to each module.
