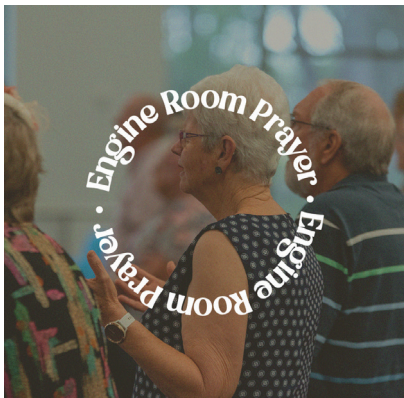

MUSIC CORNER

Music Corner is a safe space for kids to come and sing-play worship songs together, just to “jam” and have some fun.

Music Corner runs for about 30 minutes each fortnight, after the 9.30am service, where participants learn and rehearse a very small repertoire of worship songs. The vision of music corner is to help people of all ages, all backgrounds and all abilities, sing biblically faithful songs, for God's glory. *We also have a strumming group that meets monthly after our 9.30am service.*

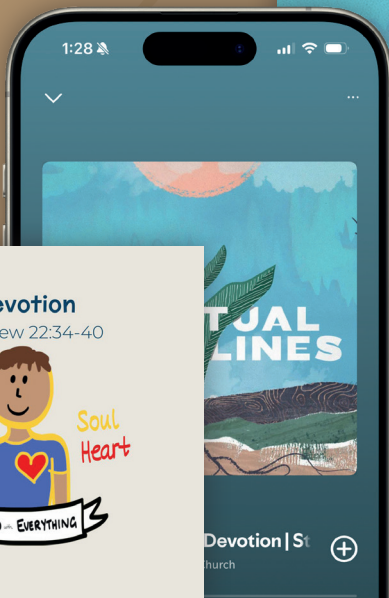

TEACHING SERIES IN 2025

At St Bart's, we hunger to grow in God's life-giving Word. The focus in our teaching series is also reflected in our Small Groups, St Bart's Kids on Sundays, and CHARGE Discussion.

TERM 1

Glory: A four-part series exploring the glory of God, Jesus as God's glory, our glory, and future glory.

Prayer + Spiritual Disciplines: As we focus on prayer in 2025, this series will start with prayer and then explore four spiritual disciplines.

TERM 2

2 Peter: A six-part series encouraging us to stand firm in what is true, be on guard against that which is false, and life faithfully as we wait for Jesus' return.

Our Mission: A three-part miniseries on our mission as a church.

Winter Warmers: The fruit of the Spirit and the character of Jesus (3 weeks).

TERM 3

Strange Religion: A tour of Acts to see what made the first Christians weird, dangerous, and compelling.

TERM 4

Leviticus: A six-part overview of Leviticus with particular focus on how this ancient book points to Jesus.

Advent: Four weeks delighting in the traditional themes of Advent as we wait confidently for Jesus' return.

CHARGE Youth is focused on youth getting connected, having fun, and growing as disciples of Jesus.

CHARGE YOUTH FRIDAYS

CHARGE meets on Friday nights from 6.30-9.00pm for Years 7-12. Each week is an opportunity to explore faith in a welcoming community. The night begins with chill time and games, before youth in Years 7-9 and 10-12 split up for age-specific activities, teaching, and small groups. We finish with all ages joining again for supper. We also have a wide array of fun social nights each term. In 2025, there will be the annual CHARGE Youth Camp and a Youth mission trip with a mission partner.

During our 9.30am Sunday service, youth in Years 7-12 meet together in age-specific small groups after the sermon to explore weekly questions whilst enjoying snacks. TRAINING CENTRE

The St Bart's Training Centre supports our mission by offering relevant courses, events, & online resources.

THE RIDLEY CERTIFICATE IN 2025

The Ridley Certificate is for those who want to go deeper, ask questions, learn more, and grow in their knowledge of the Bible. These courses are designed by Ridley College in Melbourne.

Each term we offer a six-week subject (online and in-person).

Term 1: *Understanding Your Bible*

Term 2: *Apologetics*

Term 3: *Gospel of John*

Term 4: *Aid & Development*

PARENTING CHILDREN (TERM 1)

This five-week course is for parents, prospective parents, or carers of primary-aged children.

THE MARRIAGE COURSE (TERM 2)

This seven-week course is a great way to grow your marriage. Each week includes dinner with your spouse.

PARENTING TEENAGERS (TERM 3)

This five-week course is for parents, step-parents, or carers of those with teens or pre-teens (ages 10-18 years).

INTRODUCTORY COURSES

We offer two four-week courses to help people learn more about Jesus. 'Introducing Jesus' is for those enquiring, whilst 'Following Jesus' is helpful for new disciples.

PUBLIC LECTURE

On August 11 (Toowoomba) and 12 (Brisbane) we'll host our *Annual Public Lecture*. *Speaker to be announced.*

MUSIC & DIGITAL TRAINING

Each term our music and digital teams gather to grow as followers of Jesus and in their skills as they serve him. *The sessions will be on: March 16, June 8, August 10, and October 19.*

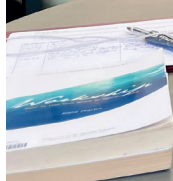

CENTRE FOR Work+Faith

The Centre for Work + Faith seeks to equip workers to explore how following Jesus transforms why we work, how we work, and how God uses our frontlines for his glory.

Work is where the majority of us spend more of our time. So what does it look like to be a disciple of Jesus in the workplace? The two key ways we seek to equip and encourage workers are through the *Transforming Work* and *RePurpose* courses.

TRANSFORMING WORK COURSE

The meeting is a chance to gather with other workers, explore what following Jesus looks like in the workplace, and pray for one another about the specific challenges and opportunities we have at work. Meets on the first Wednesday of the month (starting February 5).

You can also download materials from the London Institute of Contemporary Christianity using their 'Transforming Work' App.

RePURPOSE COURSE

For those who are retired or approaching retirement, this six-week course is on rediscovering God's purpose for retirement and growing as a disciple in this season of life. *Starting Wednesday October 15.*

LEADERSHIP *.local*

leadership.local is our approach to developing and equipping St Bart's leaders—for all of their frontlines, including the local church.

Leaders at St Bart's (i.e., *those responsible for leading teams, ministry areas, or departments*) participate in five workshops annually, each focusing on a different aspect essential to leadership. Our hope is that *leadership.local* equips people to lead not only at St Bart's, but on all of their frontlines in which they serve.

Each module is part of our leadership framework. This framework consists of 19 modules designed around a carousel (i.e., people can enter at any point on a three-year cycle).

Growing as a Disciple is at the heart of *leadership.local*. There are also three other core modules that we



encourage people to complete as they are onboarded (i.e., *leading from your strengths; the working genius; and emotional intelligence*).

Leadership.Local Modules: modules are available online for anyone who would like to make use of the materials.
