- Please. Seeking God's will for our lives, church, and world. Entrusting our requests to God and trusting his will.

- Give strength to those who face persecution and suffering. Provide for them according to their needs.
- Protect, nurture, and give strength to the underground church in Algeria, Libya, Gaza, Afghanistan, and China.

- For financial sustainability for local cafes and food businesses, particularly as many local businesses face bankruptcy.
- Help us to be kind and compassionate to those who serve us in hospitality.
- Give us grace to consider the pressures workers face each day.
- Sustain those who travel for long hours, and protect them on the roads.
- Safety for those involved in loading and unloading freight, and maintaining fleet equipment.
- Give abundant patience and grace for truck drivers, as they share the road with others.
- Sustain those who work long hours, overtime, and on public holidays to provide spaces to meet and shop.

- Provide a Senior Associate Minister who has a heart (and skills) for teaching, pastoring, and evangelism. May they have a passion for biblical teaching, love for God's people and community, and a heart for making disciples. Please bring the vacancy to their attention, remove any barriers for application, and give wisdom-in the power of God's Spirit-for discernment and in selection.
- For the provision of a Youth Minister who has a heart for nurturing young people, evangelism, and also a sound leader. May they have a heart for reaching youth, be skilled in raising up leaders, and be passionate about discipling young people. May they also have the potential to nurture and reach young adults, teach, and grow our partnerships.
- For the provision of a Church Planter who has a heart for teaching, pastoring, and leadership. May they have a great burden for the people of Brisbane (particularly Salisbury and Moorooka), long to see the lost saved, be excited about joining in with what God is already doing, and be faithful in pastoring God's people. Please remove any barrier that would prevent them from applying.
- For current advertisements for vacant roles to be effective.
- For wisdom in identifying and encouraging potential interns.
- For relationships in evangelical networks to be developed and nurtured. For long-term networks to

- be developed to help identify and source future Gospel Workers.
- For space and connections, as our Senior Minister continues to meet with people interested in Gospel Work and serving in South Queensland. Provide further leads for people interested and suited to begin soon.
- Grow our medium and long-term leadership pipelines for Gospel Workers. Give the governance and leadership teams a sense of urgency and commitment to growing leadership pipelines. That they would have clarity as well as the ability to think laterally in their approach to growing pipelines. For God to grant resources needed, and wisdom to deploy resources well.
- That we will be able to employ ordained ministers-in-training in the coming years. Along with an ample supply of ordained ministers for the church plant and other potential plants or church revitalisations.
